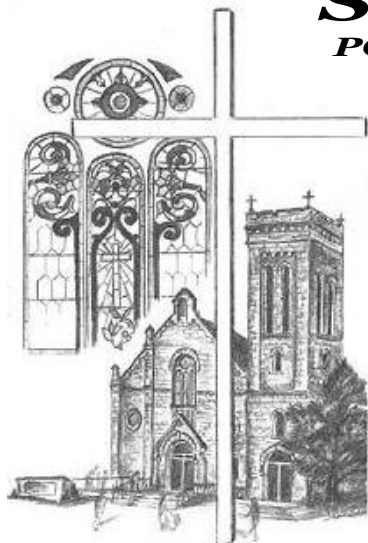

Ordinary Time in the Winter!

Ordinary Time began last Monday, January 10th and goes through Tuesday, March 1st. Although this time is called “Ordinary” it is anything but ordinary. The readings of this time invite us to deepen our relationship with the One whose birth we just celebrated. The readings open our eyes and hearts to the very miraculous dimensions of Jesus’ ministry. The directive of the Blessed Mother that opens this season, “do whatever he tells you” (Jn 2:5), is the ultimate theme of discipleship and it unfolds most elegantly as the season winds its way through the life and ministry of Jesus and our ultimate call to “drop our nets” and “follow him” (see Lk 5:4, 10).
