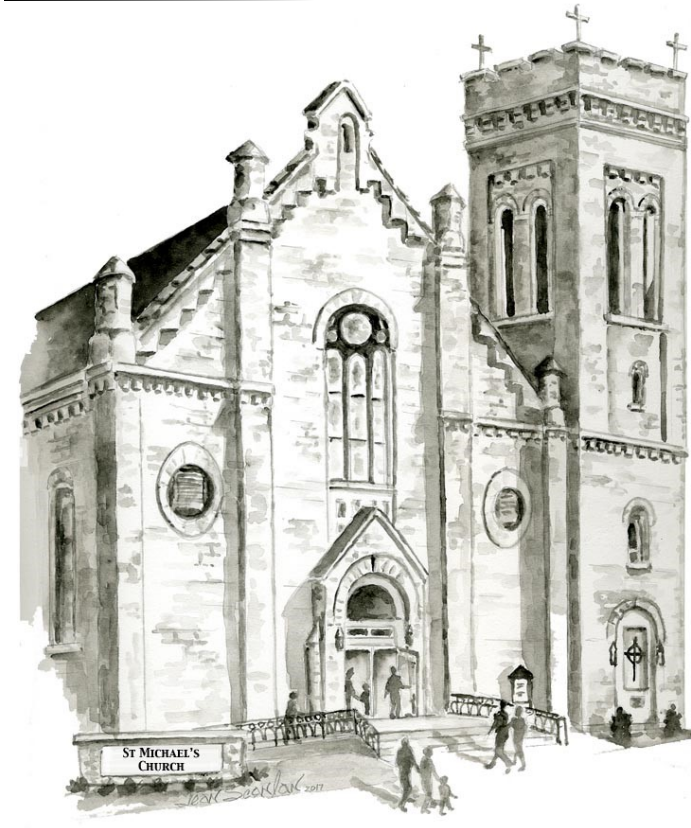

**Stewardship 2019**

Janice Carroll and Jan McCormick will speak on stewardship and packets are handed out today. **Areas of Special Need to consider:** (FYI: Committees meet a couple times a year.)

- ⇒ **Help with Servers:** help with yearly training for new servers and refresher for current servers (with Fr. John and/or Marita). Be available before Mass to help and give direction.
- ⇒ **Sacristan:** Clean and store Mass vessels, Father's microphone, turn off lights, etc. after Mass.
- ⇒ **Care of Votive Lights:** Clean out wax in 8 hour votive holders and replace candles.
- ⇒ **Substitute catechist:** Take class when regular catechist is unable to do so. Requires background check and on-line training (takes approximately 90 minutes).
- ⇒ **Vacation Bible School** (St. Michael's is hosting): June 3-7, 2019 from 9:00-11:15 a.m.; need helpers—adults & 6th-11th grade youth; and 3 yrs. old to 5th grade to attend.
- ⇒ **Bazaar Committee:** Members plan the annual parish bazaar held the 1st Sunday of Oct.
- ⇒ **Maintenance/Improvement Committee:** Making sure the church property—inside and out—is maintained and improved as needed.
- ⇒ **Stewardship Committee:** Plan, evaluate, and carry out ways of promoting stewardship especially for the annual commitment Sunday.
- ⇒ **Funeral Lunches:** Provide a salad or dessert for lunch when called and able to do so.
