

Annual Financial Report

July 2024-June 2025

Attached to the bulletin and the weekly e-mail is the Comparison of Annual Reports which provides statistics and totals of investments and accounts for the last ten years. Also, a breakdown of income and expenses for the last fiscal year of July 2024-June 2025 is at the bottom of the report.

This financial picture does not include the Capital Campaign pledges of \$38,881 which will be received over the next 2.5 years ending December 31, 2027. These funds were "borrowed" from existing accounts and those accounts will be reimbursed as pledges are paid.

While we are financially stable, we want to continue to be vigilant and to save up for rainy days. There is always maintenance when it comes to our buildings and playground and this year there is an added cost with the rotation of three priests instead of how it was before July 1st. Moreover, the spiritual meaning of stewardship is more important than paying the bills.

Your generosity for the Capital Campaign as well as your continued regular tithing for the overall parish expenses is greatly appreciated.
