

A Brief Story From Fr. Vincent!

I was born into a devout Catholic family in a small town nestled in the hills of Kerala, India. I am the sixth of seven children and was raised in a home where daily family prayers, Sunday Mass, and acts of charity were woven into everyday life. My parents were simple farmers who valued faith, education, and service.

My first inspiration to the priesthood came at the age of nine, when I served as an altar boy during a Holy Week celebration, and continued to grow through high school. After high school, I joined the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), the first indigenous religious congregation in India. Ordained a priest on December 26, 2000, I began my ministry in India, serving in parishes, schools, and seminary settings.

In response to the call of mission, my superiors sent me to Australia, where I served 16 years in the Archdiocese of Melbourne. In July 2024, at the direction of my superiors, I moved to the Diocese of Salina to continue my ministry. My first appointment was at St. Mary Queen of the Universe Parish in Salina as associate pastor. In July 2025, I was assigned to assist Fr. Peter O'Donnell in serving the parish communities of Junction City, Abilene, and Chapman. I am grateful to be here and look forward to serving the faithful in these parishes, walking together in faith, and continuing the mission of Christ in this new and welcoming community.
