

Xiomara a.k.a. Ale is St. Michael's new sponsored child through Unbound. She is nine years old and will turn 10 on August 30<sup>th</sup>. The following is information provided by Unbound.

Ale always gets first or second place in school. She is a responsible child with her tasks, and does not need to be reminded. Her jobs at home are washing

the dishes, making her bed and helping prepare the ingredients for cooking meals. She enjoys painting, playing with bakery items, pretending to make desserts and playing food preparation video games. Her health is good.

Ale attends private primary school approximately 20 minutes from home. She walks there. Her favorite subjects are math, communication, English and art. She likes to help her friends with homework.

Ale lives under the supervision of her mother and father. She has two sisters. Ale's father is the sole financial provider for the household working as an accounting assistant.

There are seven people living in the home. The walls of the home are constructed of wood, the roof is made of metal sheets, and the floor is dirt and concrete. It has electricity and they use gas for cooking. They draw water from a cistern. Ale sleeps on a wooden bed with a mattress and blankets. The road construction is lacking. The area has public lighting but they do not have water or sewage services.

Ale lives in the district of Carabyllo in Peru with stony and rugged terrain. The most frequent occupation for men is construction assistant and for women is domestic worker.
