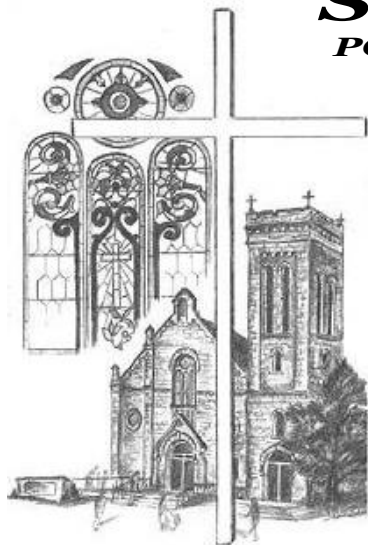

Peter's Pence Collection June 29, 2025

Today is the Peter's Pence Collection, a worldwide collection that supports the work of the Universal Church, including the work of the Holy See and the charitable works of Pope Leo. Take this opportunity to join with Pope Leo to be a sign of mercy to our suffering brothers and sisters. **FYI:** Loose plate today will go to this cause. Make checks payable to St. Michael's.

What Is Special About Today?

When the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul falls on a Sunday, it takes precedence over the Ordinary Sunday. This is because it is a solemnity, which is the highest rank for a liturgical feast.

The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul is celebrated on June 29th to honor the martyrdom of the two saints, who are believed to have been killed in Rome by Emperor Nero between 64 and 68 AD. The saints are considered pivotal figures in the history of the Church, and some say they are like complementary brothers bound by the Gospel even though they came from thoroughly different backgrounds and had different gifts.

There is a legend that the city of Rome was founded by the brothers Romulus and Remus, who were raised by wolves. Peter and Paul came to be called the new founders of Rome. Their solemnity is a grand holiday in the city, a day on which Rome celebrates itself and all its treasures. June 30th continues the celebration with the memorial of the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome.

FYI: The Liturgical color for the day is red which is used for martyrs.
