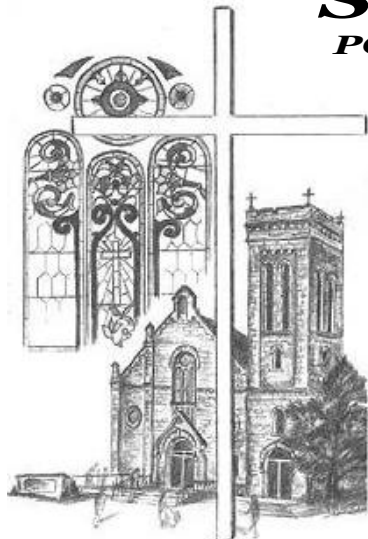

Next Sunday, Fr. Henry Saw Lone will make an appeal for Taungngu Dioc. in Myanmar (Burma). We are grateful for his visit and look forward to welcoming him with joy and prayerful support.

Myanmar, historically known as Burma, is a nation of over 60 million people in Southeast Asia, bordered by India, Bangladesh, Nepal, China, and Thailand.

Today, Myanmar is enduring another painful chapter of its long struggle — marked by darkness, violence, and oppression. Since the military coup of February 2021 and a devastating 7.7 earthquake on March 28, 2025, Myanmar has been plunged into profound darkness and suffering. What began as the collapse of democracy has developed into widespread civil unrest, mass displacement, and a devastating humanitarian crisis. Civilians are being bombed with thousands of lives lost. Villages have been destroyed. Churches, monasteries, schools, and clinics — once places of refuge and hope — have been attacked, abandoned, displaced, and denied aid.

More than 3.5 million people have been displaced amid the continuing conflict and political instability. In many parts of the country, basic healthcare and education systems have largely collapsed, leaving countless families without essential support and opportunities for the future.

The younger generation has been especially affected by fear, uncertainty, emotional trauma, and a growing loss of hope. Yet even amid this suffering, the faith of the people remains strong. The prayers, solidarity, and generosity of Catholics around the world continue to bring comfort and hope to the persecuted Church, displaced families, and struggling communities throughout Myanmar. Please continue to pray for peace, healing, and reconciliation in Myanmar.
